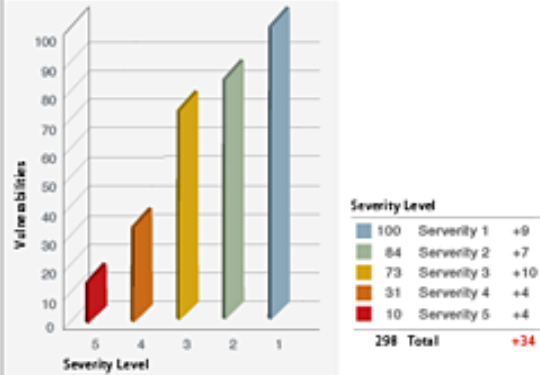

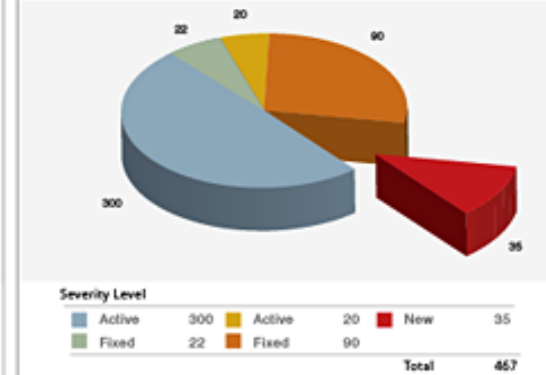
Vulnerabilities by Severity Level

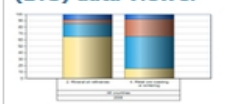

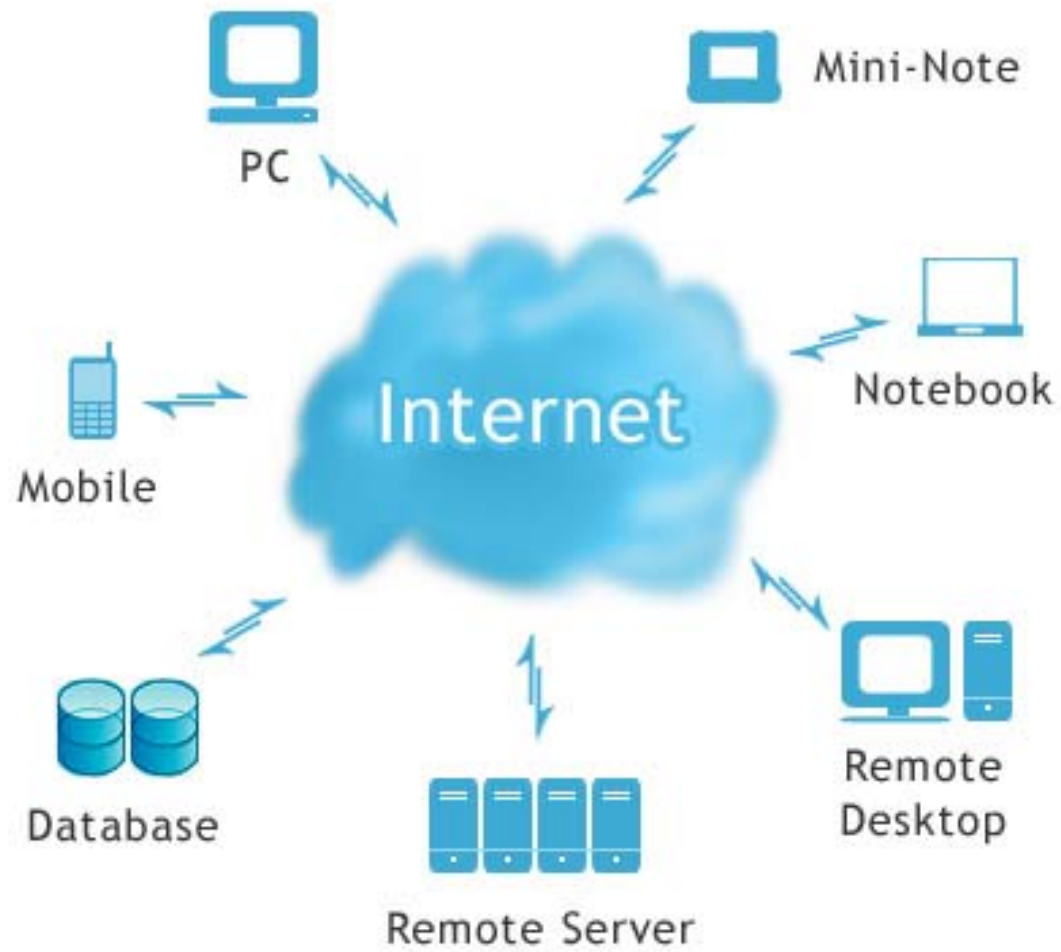
